



activity ideas

Following directions - decorate the tree! Have your child follow instructions containing concept, such as "find the <u>red</u> tinsel", "put the <u>blue</u> bauble <u>under</u> the star".

Describing! Lay out some decorations, winter items or toys, and see if your child can describe the item without saying it. Is it cold (a snowman) or warm (hot chocolate)? What colour is it? Is it fluffy (gloves) or hard (candy cane)? What do you do with it?

Listening! This is good for the little ones. See if they can recognise sounds played aloud (e.g. bells, "ho ho ho", and see if they can identify the item making that noise.


SVO sentences

Encourage your child to describe what is happening in the silly pictures, such as "Santa is sitting" or "Santa is holding a present"

Encourage your child to describe where each character is, e.g. "Santa is under the tree".
